# Airbus By Road.

*Transport of two parts of an Airbus A300-60 fuselage from Lasham Airfield, Hampshire to Dartford Docks, Kent.*

When faced with the task of moving two parts of an airplane fuselage, both measuring 5.64 meters wide out of an airfield in the middle of Hampshire to Germany, Dutch special transport company Heavy Load Service Almelo, NL came to Teahan Convoi Service (TCS) for assistance for the UK leg of the trip. TCS were responsible for first checking the suitability of the route, this proved invaluable as it became apparent that street furniture would have to be removed. This was all organized by TCS, as well as the specialist permits that are required in the UK for any transports over 5.00 meters wide.

On the day of transport, two pilot cars from TCS were on hand to safely lead the convoy out of the narrow roads of the Hampshire countryside to the highway and on to the Dartford ferry terminal in Kent. Resulting in a successful transport of an airplane.... By road!
