When our long running customer, H Rensink BV were contracted to transport a number of aluminum vessels from mainland Europe to the UK, they naturally called upon the expertise of Teahan Convoi Service to take care off all necessary permits and requirements for the UK. The final location was to be the Westons Cider factory in the small village of Much Marcle in the middle of Herefordshire. Due to the location it was considered appropriate to survey the route and site access. Although this wasn't found to be the easiest of locations, it was found to be accessible, Just!

Once the route had been confirmed, TCS made all relevant arrangements with the local police & authorities and worked to acquire all necessary transport permits & documentation. With all the legalities in place, TCS's own pilot vehicles were able to accompany the loads, some from Harwich and some from Immingham to the Westons cider factory. All the transports were delivered safety within a 4 week period. Before this project had even finished , TCS were already making arrangements for permits & escorts on behalf of Rensink for another cider factory project in Somerset, all to keep the cider flowing!
