

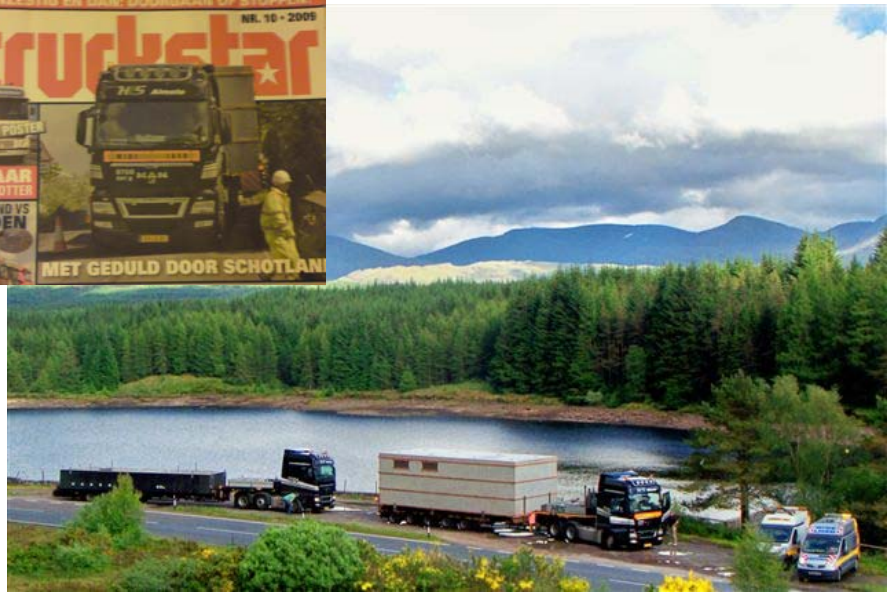

Regular customer, Heavy Load Service Almelo of Holland again approached Teahan Convoi Service (TCS) to provide them with all necessary permits and escorts for two transports they were planning to Edinbane on the Isle of Skye. After careful route planning and liaising with the relevant authorities, permits were applied for and obtained and escort arrangements were made.

On the first day of transport, a TCS pilot vehicle accompanied the two transports from Newcastle docks to Kinross where a 2nd pilot vehicle, also arranged by TCS joined the convoy. The next day, after overnighting at the Commando memorial at Spean Bridge, the convoy set off for Skye led by the two pilot vehicles. Over the two day period the convoy slowly made its way through some of the most dramatic scenery in the UK, and this was all captured for Dutch truck magazine 'Truckstar' by a journalist that was accompanying the transports.

Mid afternoon on the 2nd day and both transports had safely arrived on the hill-top site in Edinbane, Isle of Skye ready to unload. All that was left now to do is make the long, but scenic drive home.
